Dear Parent/Carer

Students that are being entered into AS Level exams in Year 12 have now received an individual statement of entry that should be checked carefully for accuracy. With the majority of subjects now reformed there are far fewer AS Level examinations taking place. Therefore, the college has decided not to have a formal period of study leave for Year 12. However, if students have an exam in the afternoon then they are excused from lessons that morning, if students have an exam in the morning then they are excused from lessons the previous afternoon.

All students in Year 12 will take mock exams in all of their A Level subjects w/b 26 June. These exams are very important as we will be relying on the mock exams for predicted grades as well as enrolment into Year 13.

In order to maximise success, it is important that all students now begin a regular revision programme at home and that work and social commitments are scaled back. Of particular importance is the upcoming Easter break, as examinations begin only three weeks after we return. In order to gain the most benefit from the exam preparation lessons teachers will be running, students should come back having thoroughly learned all the subject content their exams will require.

To continue with a subject into Y13 (where the courses become significantly more difficult), students should achieve at least grade D in either their AS Level exam or mock exam. Students that do not achieve this will need to meet with me at enrolment on Friday 1 September.
