Summer examinations are now on the horizon and your son/daughter has received an individual statement of entry which needs to be checked carefully for accuracy, I have also included a copy of this for your information. Of particular importance is the upcoming Easter break, as any re-sit examinations will begin only three weeks after we return. In order to gain the most benefit from the exam preparation lessons teachers will be running, students should come back having thoroughly learned all the subject content their exams will require.

A2 courses have their last formal lesson on Friday 26 May. Students are then on study leave but their teachers will be available to offer support and to answer any questions. After the A2 exams are completed all Year 13 students are asked to come into college for Signing Off day.

- Friday 30 June – Year 13 Signing Off day
- Wednesday 5 July – Year 13 Leavers' Party
- Thursday 17 August - A Level Results' Day from 8:30 am

If your son/ daughter has applied for University in September, they should now be applying for student finance. This has to be done, online, by students and parents/ carers as family income details need to be submitted (link available from the UCAS website). If this is not done by 30th May there is an increased possibility of money not arriving in time for September.
